



REWRITING THE FIRST CRUSADE

Epistolary Culture in the Middle Ages THOMAS W. SMITH

An exploration of the letters from the First Crusade, yielding evidence for a number of reinterpretations of the movement.

Grounded on extensive research into the original manuscripts, and presenting numerous new manuscript witnesses, this book argues that some letters from the first crusade are post hoc "inventions", composed by generations of scribereaders who visited crusading sites from the twelfth century on. Drawing upon this new understanding, and blurring the distinction of epistolary "reality", it rewrites central aspects of the history of the First Crusade, considering the documents in a new way: as markers of enthusiasm and support for the crusade movement among monastic clergy, who copied and consumed them as a form of scribal crusading.


