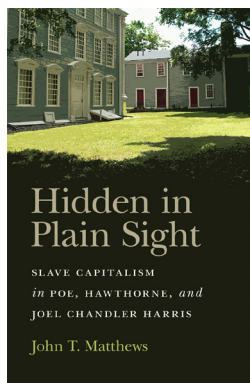


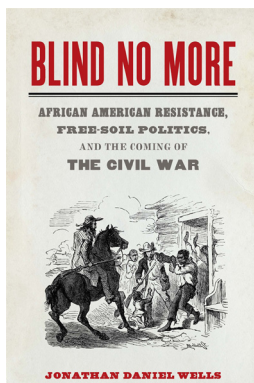
MERCER UNIVERSITY LAMAR MEMORIAL LECTURES
