Indiana University Press is pleased to have the privilege of publishing your article, review, briefing, photo essay, or multimedia contribution (hereinafter the “Contribution”)

in *Chiricú Journal: Latina/o Literatures, Arts, and Cultures* (hereinafter “the Journal”) in both print and electronic formats.

You, as Author, and the Press hereby agree as follows:

1. Whereas the Press is undertaking to publish the Contribution in the Journal, the Author grants and assigns to the Press the full and exclusive rights during the term of copyright to publish or cause others to publish the said Contribution in all forms, in all media, and in all languages throughout the world.
2. In consideration of the rights granted above, the Press grants the Author, without charge, the right to republish the Contribution in revised or unrevised form, in any language, in any volume consisting entirely of the Author’s own work or in any volume edited by the Author, provided the Press is notified of such use and that it carries the appropriate copyright notice and standard form of scholarly acknowledgement.

- a. In addition, the Author may post a preprint version of the Contribution on personal websites and in-home institutional repositories (IR). A preprint is the version of the article that is sent to a journal editor after review and revision but before copy editing. The preprint version must indicate that the article is a “working paper.”
 - b. The Author may post a postprint using the JSTOR-created PDF (that is, the final published version of the article) on their personal website and/or one’s home IR eighteen (18) months after publication, or sooner as required by law. (We do not consider for-profit repositories such as ResearchGate, Google Scholar, Academia.edu, and/or the Social Science Research Network as one’s in-home IR.) Additionally, the request for IR deposits must come from the Author.
 - c. When the Contribution is reprinted or appears online as a postprint, please include the following attribution: “This [selection] was published as [insert complete bibliographic citation as it appears in the print journal]. No part of it may be reproduced, stored in a retrieval system, transmitted, or distributed in any form, by any means, electronic, mechanical, photographic, or otherwise, without the prior permission of Indiana University Press. For education reuse, please contact the Copyright Clearance Center <<http://www.copyright.com/>>. For all other permissions, contact IU Press at <<http://iupress.indiana.edu/rights/>>.”
3. The Author represents and guarantees that she/he is the sole creator or author and proprietor of the said Contribution and has full power to make this agreement and grant, that the Contribution does not infringe the copyright or other proprietary right of any other person, that it contains no libelous or other unlawful matter, that it makes no improper invasion of the privacy of any other person, and that the Contribution is original with the Author and has not previously been published.
 - a. The Author agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Press and the publisher of any reprint of the Contribution licensed by the Press against any final judgment for damages arising out of facts which constitute a breach of the foregoing warranties; the Author will also pay reasonable costs and attorneys’ fees incurred by the publisher(s) in defending an action in which such judgment is recovered.
 - b. The Press shall give the Author prompt notice of any suit brought against the Press, or its licensees, alleging facts, that, if proven, could constitute a breach of the warranties specified herein. The Author may defend such suit with counsel of her/his choosing, at her/his expense, providing that the Press may, nonetheless, participate in the defense with counsel of the Press’s choosing and at its expense. If the Author defends such suit, the Author shall not be responsible for the Press’s attorneys’ fees.
 4. The Author agrees to permit publication of short selections, in either print or electronic format, from the Contribution for publicity and scholarly purposes, without payment to the Press or the Author, as deemed necessary and appropriate by the Press. Please ensure that the reprinted work carries the proper form of attribution (see Section 2(c) above).
 5. The Author grants and assigns to the Press the full, sole, and exclusive right to arrange for the sale or licensing of the following subsidiary rights to the Contribution and constitutes the Press her/his representative and attorney-in-fact for that purpose: serial, foreign, translation, selection,

abridgment, condensation, digest, anthology, adaptation, syndication, omnibus volumes, reproduction by xerography or other photocopying and related processes, Braille, and reproduction by electronic, digital, optical, magnetic, or other means.

6. The Press shall arrange for registration of copyright in the name of Indiana University Latino Studies Program on behalf of the Trustees of Indiana University in accordance with the provisions of the Copyright Revision Act of 1976. The Press shall pay all fees related to these transactions.
7. Illustrations may be included only at the discretion of the editor(s). If illustrations or any other copyrighted materials are reproduced in a contribution, the Author will bear all responsibility for:
 - a. Preparing the illustrations according to the publisher's specifications and providing them in final scanned form or digitally/electronically in a Press-approved format;
 - b. Obtaining the necessary written permissions—using the IU Press provided image reprint request letter—for reproduction from the copyright holder prior to publication and submitting the original copies of those permissions to the editorial office with this form; and
 - c. Covering all costs and fees associated with these requirements.
8. Contributors to the Journal shall receive online access to the issues in which their Contributions are published for a period of one year from the date of publication. Contributors may purchase print copies of those issues for personal use and not for resale at 40 percent off the regular list price, plus shipping, by calling the Customer Service Department at 1-800-842-6796 (inside the US) or 1-812-855-8817 (outside the US) or via e-mail <iuporder@indiana.edu>.
