

RESPONSIVE READING OF 1 CORINTHIANS 2:10–16, NRSV (for three readers)

- Reader 1: These things God has revealed to us through the Spirit;
- Reader 2: for the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God.
- Reader 3: For what human being knows what is truly human except the human spirit that is within?
- Reader 2: So also no one comprehends what is truly God's except the Spirit of God.
- Reader 1: Now we have received
- Reader 3: not the spirit of the world,
- Reader 2: but the Spirit that is from God, so that we may understand the gifts bestowed on us by God.
- Reader 1: And we speak of these things in words
- Reader 3: not taught by human wisdom
- Reader 2: but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual things to those who are spiritual.
- **Reader 3:** Those who are unspiritual do not receive the gifts of God's Spirit, for they are foolishness to them, and they are unable to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.
- Reader 2: Those who are spiritual discern all things, and they are themselves subject to no one else's scrutiny.
- Reader 1: "For who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?" (Isaiah 40:13)
- Readers 1, 2, 3: But we have the mind of Christ.
