aseball Italian Style brings together the memories of major leaguers of Italian heritage whose collective careers span almost a century, from the 1930s up to today. In these first-person accounts, baseball fans will meet at an intimate level the players they cheered as heroes or jeered as adversaries, as well as coaches, managers, front-office executives, and umpires. The men who speak in this collection, which includes eight Hall of Famers (Yogi Berra, Phil Rizzuto, Ron Santo, Craig Biggio, Mike Piazza, Tom Lasorda, Tony La Russa, and Joe Torre) go beyond facts and figures to provide an inside look at life in the big leagues. Their stories provide a time capsule that documents not only the evolution of Italian American participation in the national pastime but also the continuity of the game and the many changes that have taken place, on and off the field. At a time when statistical analysis plays an increasingly prominent role in the sport, the monologues in this book are a reminder that the history of baseball is passed on to future generations more eloquently, and with much greater passion, through the words of those who lived it than it is by numerical data.



Arizona. Kentucky. Indiana. It's astounding to think that three elite college basketball programs can trace their success back to one small-town high school coach, Blackhawk High's legendary John Miller.

Coach John Miller was just following his heart's passion and channeling his unbreakable spirit when in the early 1980s he began to use basketball as a platform for developing young players and future leaders. Little could he have known that his two sons, Sean and Archie Miller, and cousin, John Calipari, would grow up to lead historic basketball programs to national prominence. And over his career, he also inspired countless other young players, who would grow up to become doctors, lawyers, and prominent CEOs. At his retirement in 2005, Coach Miller's record stood at 657–280 over his thirty-five-year career, making him one of the winningest coaches in high school basketball history.

Today, Coach Miller's legacy extends from the tiny hamlet of Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania, to some of the most famous sporting venues in America. He is a legend in the sport, praised by greats such as Kobe Bryant, Thad Matta, Bucky Waters, and Jamie Dixon.




n 1943, while the New York Yankees and St. Louis Cardinals were winning pennants and meeting in that year's World Series, one of the nation's strongest baseball teams practiced on a skinned-out college field in the heart of North Carolina. Ted Williams, Johnny Pesky, and Johnny Sain were among a cadre of fighter-pilot cadets who wore the Cloudbuster Nine baseball jersey at an elite Navy training school at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. As a child, Anne Keene's father, Jim Raugh, suited up as the team batboy and mascot. He got to know his baseball heroes personally, watching players hit the road on cramped, tin-can buses, dazzling factory workers, kids, and service members at dozens of games, including a war-bond exhibition with Babe Ruth at Yankee Stadium. He would have carried this story to his grave had Anne not discovered his scrapbook from a Navy school that shaped America's greatest heroes, including George H. W. Bush, Gerald Ford, John Glenn, and Paul "Bear" Bryant. 





Though other books have recounted Williams's career, none have done so through the eyes of someone like Enberg, who followed Ted's career as just a young boy, trying to emulate his classic swing, then as a broadcaster, and finally as a friend, when the two men could enjoy numerous get-togethers until Ted's passing in 2002. Enberg and Clavin also weave in personal stories from others who knew and admired Ted, such as Bobby Knight, Senator John McCain, Emily DiMaggio, and many more.


DICK ENBERG, a veteran of sixty years of sports broadcasting and the author of two bestselling books, is the only person to win National Emmy Awards as a sportscaster, writer, and producer. He has been inducted into the National Sports Broadcasting Hall of Fame, National Sportscaster and Sportswriters HOF, and several sports HOFs. Having joined NBC Sports in 1975, Enberg served as the play-by-play voice of a variety of sporting events. In 2000, he joined CBS Sports and ESPN. Enberg was the announcer for the Los Angeles Angels for thirteen seasons, and after seven seasons (2010–2016) he concluded his role as the TV voice of the San Diego Padres on FSSD. Enberg resides with his wife, Barbara, in La Jolla, California.





With 363 victories, Warren Spahn is the winningest left-handed pitcher in baseball history. During his twenty-one-year career, Spahn won 20+ games thirteen times, was a 17-time All Star, a Cy Young Award winner, and was elected to the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1973. In addition, Spahn was a war hero, serving in World War II, and awarded the Purple Heart.

To say Spahn lived a storied life is an understatement.

When Spahn struggled in his major league debut at age twenty, manager Casey Stengel demoted the young lefty. It would be four years before Spahn would return to the diamond, as he received a calling of a different kind—one from his country.

Enlisting in the Army, Spahn would serve with distinction, seeing action in the Battle of the Bulge and the Ludendorff Bridge, and was awarded a battlefield commission along with a Purple Heart.

Upon his return to the game, he would take the league by storm. Spahn dominated for more than two decades, spending twenty years with the Braves (both Boston and Milwaukee), as well as a season with the New York Mets and San Francisco Giants. Pitching into his mid-forties, he would throw two no-hitters at the advanced ages of thirty-nine and forty.


From his early days in Buffalo and young career, through his time in the military, and all the way to the 1948 Braves and "Spahn and Sain and Pray for Rain," author Lew Freedman leaves no stone unturned in sharing the incredible life of this pitching icon, who is still considered the greatest left-handed pitcher to ever play the game.

n 1884, professional baseball was still in its infancy. The National League was less than a decade old, the National Association was now defunct, the American Association was nipping at the NL's heels, and a new league—the Union Association—was in its first year.

With all that going on, a hard-playing, hard-drinking club out of tiny Wilmington, Delaware—the Quicksteps—were so dominating their minor-league opponents that they would receive the opportunity of a lifetime.

At 51–12, the Quicksteps were easily handling the Eastern League. Led by archetypal stars Tommy "Oyster" Burns and Edward "The Only" Nolan, the Quicksteps attacked opponents with a spike-sharpened, rough-and-tumble approach to the game that was only then coming into style, clinching the league title with six weeks left in the season.

The UA's inaugural season wasn't going as well as they had hoped, with four teams folded before the season's conclusion, and the redhot Quicksteps slated to be promoted to the professional league.

Unfortunately, things did not go as well for Wilmington in the UA as they did in the Eastern League. As the first shots were fired in a near century-long battle for player rights, mass defections and a comedy of on-field error and misfortune resigned the Quicksteps to a virtually unassailable record for baseball futility. In 18 games, the Quicksteps went 2–16, giving them a .111 winning percentage. The UA would fold at seasons' end—as would the Quicksteps.


